



1. Walk
2. Walk over logs
3. Lope right lead
4. Extended lope right lead
5. Trot
6. Stop, 1 1/2 turn right
7. Walk
8. Trot
9. Extended trot
10. Lope left lead
11. Stop and back
12. Side pass right

Note: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Exhibitors should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.

WALK TROT: Novice Horse, Novice Rider
Green Horse, Green Rider & Youth



1. Start: Extended Walk
2. Transition to a regular Walk.
3. Stop and 1 spin to the right OR the left (either one)
4. Walk over the logs.
5. Trot.
6. Extended Trot.
7. Stop and Back 8 steps.

**Open, Non Pro, Novice Horse, Novice Rider,
Green Horse & Green Rider & Youth**

Videographer stands in the MIDDLE of the arena/riding area.

Videographer acts as Announcer and announces transitions according to timeframes stated by the "pattern" below.

If you are using a pivo please announce (loudly) the maneuvers.

START TRACKING LEFT:

1. WALK (for 5-10 seconds)
2. Transition to Trot (for 20-25 seconds)
3. Transition Left Lead Lope (for 20-25 seconds)
4. Transition to Extended Lope (for 20-25 seconds)
5. Transition to Extended Walk (for 20-25 seconds)
6. Change Directions and pick up Trot (for 20-25 seconds)

NOW TRACKING RIGHT

7. Transition to Extended Trot (for 20-25 seconds)
8. Transition to Extended Walk (for 5-10 seconds)
9. Transition to Right Lead Lope (for 20-25 seconds)
10. Transition to Trot (for 20-25 seconds)
11. HALT along the rail
12. Back 8 Steps
13. Hesitate to show completion of class

Ranch Pleasure Pattern

Videographer stands in the MIDDLE of the arena/riding area.

Videographer acts as Announcer and announces transitions according to timeframes stated by the "pattern" below. If you are using a pivo, please announce (loudly) before the maneuver. Please video


Landscape/Horizontal (please NOT PORTRAIT). Make sure the judge can visibly see the horse and rider.

START TRACKING LEFT:

1. Start at the Halt
2. Walk (5-10 seconds)
3. Transition to EXTENDED TROT (for 20-25 seconds)
4. Transition to TROT (for 20-25 seconds)
5. Transition to WALK (5-10 seconds)
6. Halt.
7. Back 8 steps
8. Reverse directions.
9. NOW TRACKING RIGHT- EXTENDED WALK (for 5-10 seconds)
10. Transition to TROT (for 20-25 seconds)
11. Transition to EXTENDED TROT (for 20-25 seconds)
12. HALT along the rail
13. Hesitate to show completion of class

Ranch Conformation

All Divisions



- 1.Walk straight toward Videographer.
- 2.Once you get past videographer, trot away.
- 3.Trot around first, second and third cone.
- 4.Once around third cone, walk straight toward videographer.
- 5.Halt in front of videographer.
- 6.Set Up for inspection.
- 7.Videographer, while including the whole horse in the video, walk around the horse twice. Please make sure you are not too close and that the video includes the whole horse as you walk around.



1. Start: Back 4 Steps
2. Walk to cone A
3. Trot from A to B
4. Walk to Judge
5. Set Up for Inspection (Videographer walk around horse one time. Please make sure you are not too close and that the video includes the whole horse and exhibitor as you walk around.)
6. After inspection hesitate to show completion of pattern*



Ranch Showmanship is a class that evaluates how effectively an exhibitor prepares, handles, and presents a ranch horse in a practical, work-like manner. The focus is on the partnership between horse and handler, emphasizing proper grooming, conditioning, control, and confident presentation while performing a prescribed pattern. Judging is based on horsemanship, attention to detail, and the exhibitor's ability to showcase a capable, well-prepared ranch horse rather than the horse's conformation.

Ranch Division Eligibility – Quick Reference

Division	Intended For	Gaits Allowed
Green Horse Ranch	Horses new to ranch; less than 3 ranch class wins	Walk-Trot-Lope
Green Rider Ranch	Riders new to ranch; less than 3 ranch class wins	Walk-Trot-Lope
Novice Horse	Horses beyond Green, developing toward Non-Pro or Open	Walk-Trot-Lope
Novice Rider	Riders beyond Green, developing toward Non-Pro or	Walk-Trot-Lope
Non Pro Ranch	Exhibitors with no paid coaching, judging, or training within past 5 years	Walk-Trot-Lope
Open Ranch	All horses and exhibitors	Walk-Trot-Lope
Youth Ranch	Riders 18 & under as of Jan 1	Walk-Trot-Lope
Green Horse Ranch W/T	New horses not ready to lope; no lope classes allowed	Walk-Trot
Green Rider Ranch W/T	New riders not ready to lope; no lope classes allowed	Walk-Trot
Novice Horse W/T	Horses beyond Green W/T, developing toward loping ranch classes; no lope classes allowed for horse	Walk-Trot
Novice Rider W/T	Riders beyond Green W/T, developing toward loping ranch classes; no lope classes allowed for rider	Walk-Trot
Youth Ranch W/T	Youth 18 & under not ready to lope; no lope classes allowed for rider	Walk-Trot

*Novice divisions are intended as transitional classes and may not be combined with Green divisions within the same show/series.

Novice Horse/Rider Walk Trot Lope (WTL) CAN be combined with Non-Pro, Open and Youth.

New Divisions Progression

Horse Track: Green Horse → Novice Horse → Youth / Non-Pro / Open

Rider Track: Green Rider → Novice Rider → Youth / Non-Pro / Open
